

The Modern Jewel: In time and the mind of others

25 March – 10 July 2011

Ground Floor Galleries

The Modern Jewel is a major new contemporary jewellery exhibition and mima's largest presentation of jewellery to date. As part of *museumaker*, over the last year Middlesbrough Museums and Galleries have been working with makers Ted Noten and Lin Cheung & Laura Potter, to commission pieces of jewellery for the collection and the people of Middlesbrough. Taking over four large gallery spaces, the new works will be shown alongside other works from Middlesbrough collection and pieces by Maisie Broadhead.

museumaker is a prestigious national project, involving sixteen museums across four participating regions, funded by Arts Council England and MLA and its Renaissance programme. It is unlocking the creative potential of collections through imaginative interchanges between the heritage and contemporary craft sectors.

museumaker is a collaborative initiative across Middlesbrough Museums Service, mima, The Dorman Museum and Captain Cook Birthplace Museum.

mima presents a major touring exhibition by renowned British artist Carey Young. The show features a variety of works in video, photography and text to explore ideas of rhetoric, protest and performance in the light of economic globalisation and the rise of legalistic culture.

The new commission *Memento Park* (2010), a video shot in the suburban environs of Budapest's Soviet statue park, extends these interests into a subtle meditation on propaganda and contemporary leftist identity.

Commissioned by mima, Eastside Projects, Birmingham and Cornerhouse, Manchester.

 mima Soundspace and Atrium

Sam Belinfante's projects endeavour to bridge the gap between the visual and the musical. His film works, for example, exist in a curious space between performance and documentation.

For *Penumbra* musicians are asked to take an improvised journey across their voice. During this an array of sounds, both intentional

and accidental, are emitted in the gradual search of a clearly voiced tone.

Running alongside this aural expedition is an optical one; the performer's movements are paralleled by that of the camera. As sounds emerge, so do images, as the camera's lens pulls in and out of focus in duet with the musician.

The exhibition will include traditional collage on paper, alongside painting, sculpture, film and slide projections, with all works drawn from the Arts Council Collection.

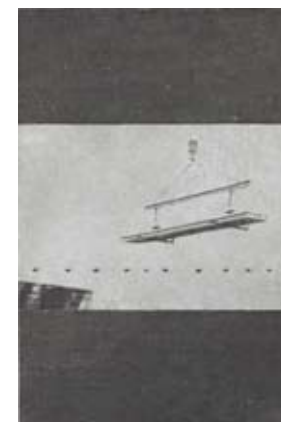
Ben Nicholson The Intimate Surface of Modernism

mima is delighted to present an exhibition of 52 new drawings by North-East based British artist Richard Forster, in his first museum solo show. The drawings, completed over a calendar year, are a narrative that juxtaposes the shifting sea line at Saltburn-by-the-Sea with the construction of pioneer social housing in eastern Germany. Collection Spotlight



As part of the recent *museumaker* project, new pieces of jewellery have been commissioned in pairs, one piece for the museums' collections, another for a chosen member of the public to keep. Artist Lin Cheung spent time with members of the public Lucinda and Charlotte in mima's collection stores looking at the jewellery collection. A particular favorite of Charlotte's was this necklace by Jacqueline Mina. This went on to inspire Lin Cheung and Laura Potter's final piece for Charlotte, on display now in *The Modern Jewel* exhibition.

The piece is significant in mima's collection of contemporary jewellery in that it marks a change in mima's collecting trend. Focusing on the New Jewellery Movement, the collection previously concentrated on the use of non-traditional materials and challenges of wearability. mima has now recently moved towards collecting precious materials as well, largely in response to changes in contemporary goldsmithing.

This piece was Mina's prizewinning entry to the Jerwood Applied Arts Prize 2000.

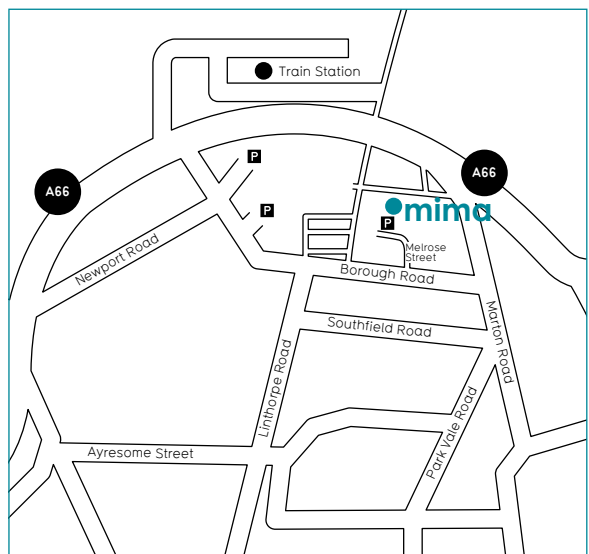
