



Sensory Art Work Commission

Brief

We are looking for an artist/s to create sculptural art work piece which will incorporate an audio recording exploring contrasting cultural journeys.

The art commission can be in any form which entices members of the public to be engaged and intrigued.

The audio recording has already been produced which combines music and storytelling, this will be provided to the artists in an MP3 format to incorporate in to their art work.

The art work will first be showcased at the Middlesbrough Mela on 17 – 18 August 2019 and must be able to be transported in a long wheel based van.

The structure will be used outdoors and will require to be self-supporting and not require any additional provision.

Artists will require to attend a creative day on Friday 21 June to help feed in to the creative concepts of the Mela participation programme.

Successful artist/s must be registered self-employed and be able to provide public liability insurance and submit risk assessment on created structure
